- Provide a safe and healthful work environment and assure compliance using appropriate management systems.
- Devote appropriate resources to occupational health and safety performance and train DEP personnel in safe work practices and good industrial hygiene work principles.
- Design, operate, inspect, and maintain our facilities to protect our employees, contractors and the public from injury and illness resulting from our activities.
- Routinely review health and safety performance in our operations to ensure compliance with existing laws and policies and make improvements in policies and practices as called for to assure compliance and effectiveness.
- Hold employees accountable for performing safely and make health and safety performance a factor in evaluating and rewarding DEP personnel.
- Emphasize health and safety performance in selecting contracting firms and require that contractors manage health and safety in line with this policy to meet their responsibility that their employees, when working at DEP locations, are properly trained, comply with applicable laws and regulations and use appropriate safe work practices. As appropriate, DEP will provide specific information about DEP operations to our contractors to better enable them to fulfill their health and safety obligations.
- Encourage government, industry, professional associations, the public, and others to develop appropriate and cost effective health and safety criteria and regulations relating to our workplaces and products.
- Require subsidiaries and joint ventures under our control to manage health and safety in line with this policy and use our influence to promote it in other ventures.

- Emphasize environmental performance in selecting contractors, and require them to manage environmental matters in line with this policy.
- Encourage government, industry, professional associations, the public, and others to develop appropriate and cost effective environmental criteria and regulations relating to our operations and use of our products.
- Foster constructive dialogue with communities and others with regard to health and the environment.
- Encourage and support research to improve environmental understanding and methods of environmental protection.
- Require subsidiaries and joint ventures under our control to manage environmental performance in line with this policy and use our influence to promote it in other ventures.
